## LIBRARY LENDING LOCKERS

### What are Library Lending Lockers?

Designed to extend the coverage and accessibility of the library, Library Lending Lockers offer residents convenient self-service holds pick-up, browsing, and returns.

### How can I use the lockers?

Residents in Bragg Creek, Rocky View County, and surrounding municipalities have access to the Library Lending Lockers through Rocky View County's membership in Marigold Library System. With a current Marigold (TRAC) library card issued by Marigold or any participating member library, you may access the Library Lending Lockers.

The lockers are located in the Bragg Creek Community Center, 403-949-4227. Instructions on using the lockers are available at the locker installation or online at [braggcreeklibrary.ca](http://braggcreeklibrary.ca).

### How do I get a library card?
